Most funding for the provision of education and the operation of the school is provided by the NSW Department of Education and Communities. In addition to this, we do seek support from parents with regard to the payment of a contribution towards their child's educational expenses.

- General school contribution – This contribution helps cover part of the cost of the essential educational items provided. This includes student essential items such as stationery and art supplies.
- Technology and school based activity Levy – This levy covers access to Athletics, Spelling City and other computer based programs. Students' access to these web-based programs integrates both home and school learning via the Internet. This levy also covers part of the cost of providing students with opportunities to participate in and attend visiting performances and other programs such as Life Education, UNE Science Day and NAIDOC week activities. These are all school based activities that do *not* require bus travel.

Students will be offered a variety of extra-curricular activities (ie excursions) throughout the year to complement the educational programs. These will be provided on a user-pays basis. The school will continue to subsidize the cost of these activities to keep them affordable.

We have maintained fees as low as possible despite increases in costs and would appreciate payment of the attached invoice at your earliest convenience. Parents having trouble making payments should discuss the range of support options available with the Principal and negotiate alternative arrangements as soon as possible.

You may wish to make contributions via a payment plan to assist with your budgeting. As little as \$5 per week is acceptable and this would ensure fees are paid by the end of Term 2. A statement will be sent home at the beginning of each term to allow you to make regular payments. Another statement will be sent home at the end of each term as a reminder of the balance due. We thank you for your continued financial support of Red Range Public School.
