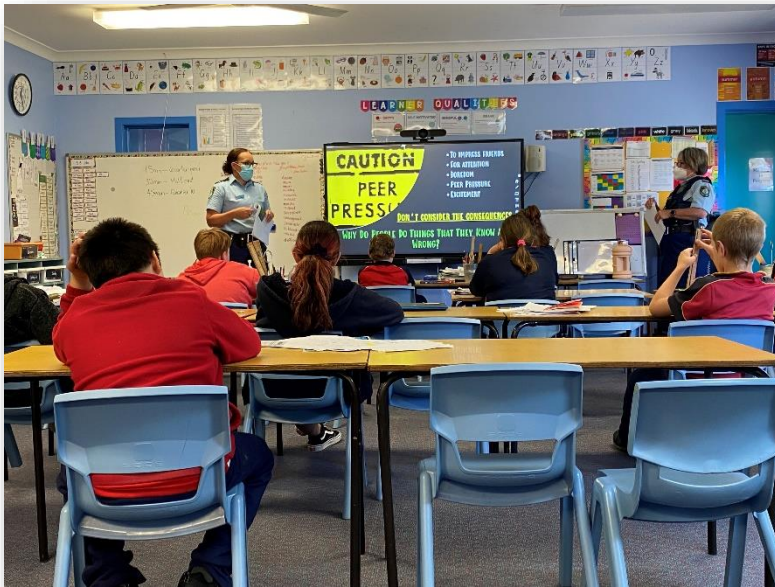


## School wellbeing visit from Police
