## **Year 4 and Year 6 Check-in Assessments**

During Term 2 Week 6 and Week 7 our Year 4 and Year 6 students will participate in Check-in assessments.

The Check-in assessment is the NSW Department of Education online literacy and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessment can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

Students with disability may receive the same level of support during assessment they would normally receive in the classroom.

The assessments will occur during class time in week 6 and week 7.

All students will complete a reading assessment and a numeracy assessment.

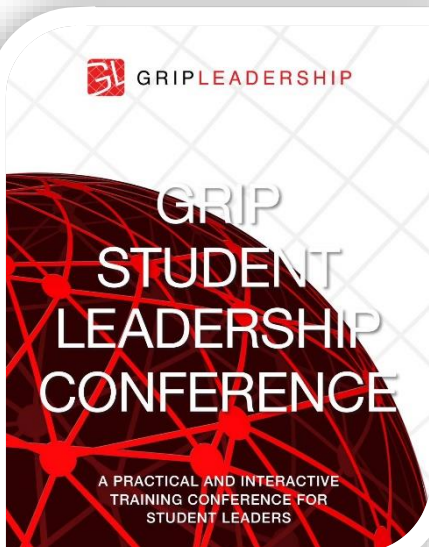
