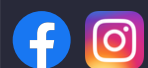

A reminder that notes and payments for our Stage 3 Coffs Harbour excursion are due on Friday 25th August. Please contact the school if you would like to discuss this further.

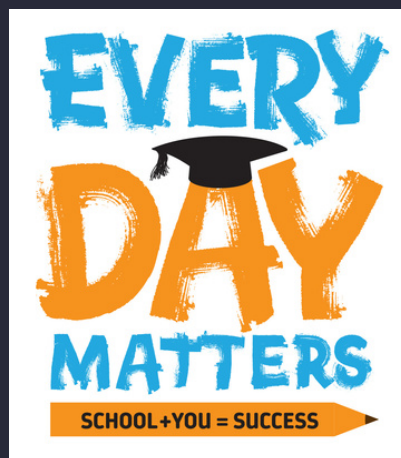

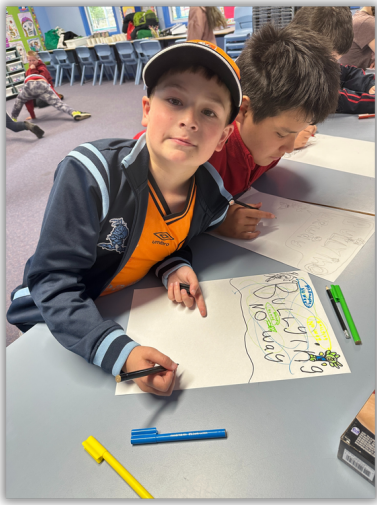

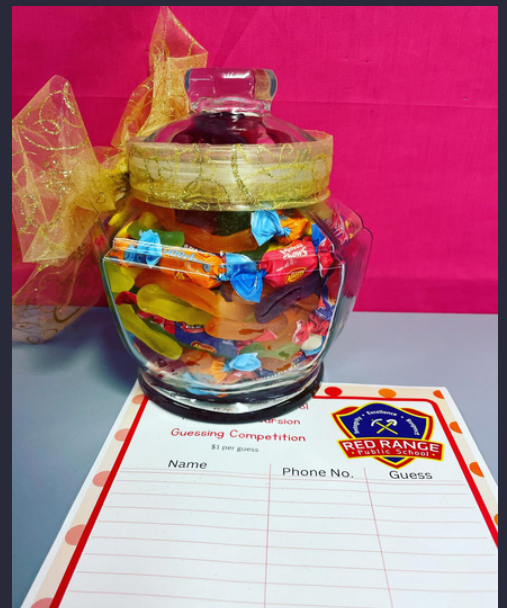


### Stage 3 Guessing Competition

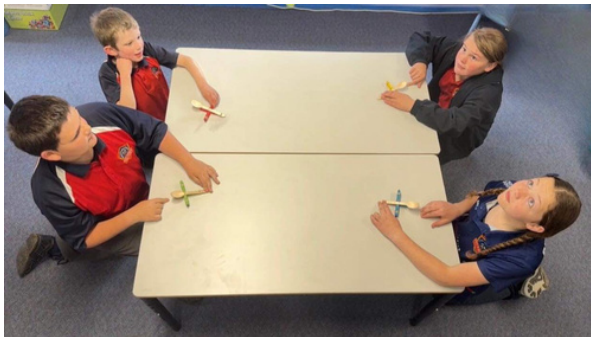
