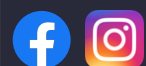

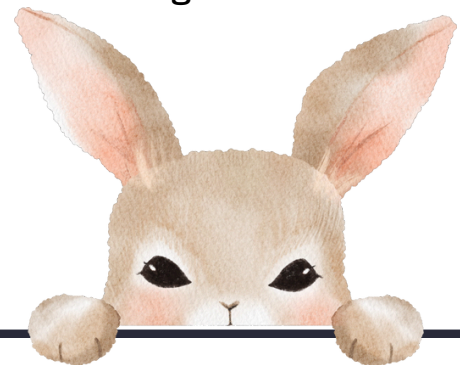
ANZAC DAY MARCH 2025

5.30am Glen Innes Dawn Service - at Glen Innes Cemetery in Grafton Street

Commences Promptly at 5.30 am followed by the unveiling of graves.

7.30am. - Veterans, Pipe Band members and interested parties will drive to Deepwater, by bus or private car, to support the Deepwater March and Service - 41kms and approx. 30-minute drive.

DEEPWATER ANZAC DAY

08.30am - ANZAC March Commences from the Deepwater Post Office via Severn Street and then Dundee Street to the School of Arts Building, where a Commemorative Service will be held.


